Great is Thy Faithfulness

“Faithful the Lord has been, and Faithful He will be.” What an incredible truth to cling to as we reflect on Easter and what Jesus did for us. As we head into our last semester of the year, we can reflect and see how the Lord has been so faithful and kind to us. This month, as a family, you will be reflecting on how God has shown his faithfulness this school year. Faithfulness is one of the incredible characteristics of God. His faithfulness can be seen all around us. Below are some questions and verses to walk through as a family.

First, as a family, define faithfulness below.

Read Deuteronomy 31:6 together as a family.

Be strong and courageous, do not be afraid or tremble at them, for the LORD your God is the one who goes with you. He will not fail you or forsake you.”

When was a time this year when you were afraid and had to trust God? How did you see God work through that time?

Read and discuss 2 Timothy 2:13 together.

“If we are faithless, He remains faithful—for He cannot deny himself”

How often have we been unfaithful? We have been unfaithful to family, friends, the family of God, and even God Himself. Spend time together thanking God our unfaithfulness cannot cancel out the faithfulness of God.

We have seen all throughout scripture God has shown His faithfulness time and time again. In response to His love and kindness we can also show faithfulness to Him.

Read Luke 16:10 together as a family.

“One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much.”
