Directions:

* For this book report, you must use a book you have not already filled out a report form for.

Slide 1: This is your "title slide." On this slide you will list your name, the title of the book, the author's name, and the date of publication. You may also choose to include a picture of the book cover.

Slide 2: Describe the setting (time and place) of the book. Include at least one picture to help describe the setting of the story.

Slides 3, 4, and 5: Pick **three** characters from your book and make one slide for each one of them. Include **two** adjectives to describe each character's personality, and a picture representing each character.

Slide 6: Describe a summary of the story. What problem does the main character face? What obstacles does he or she have to overcome?

Slide 7: Describe your favorite part of of the book.

Slide 8: Recommendation: Include a recommendation that explains why the book is worth reading or not!
