Summer Reading Entering 7th Grade

Step 1: Go to the library or bookstore with your parents to select a nonfiction book on the topic of leadership, about a Christian ministry, about a missionary, about practical life skills, or a book about a person, place, or event that has had a positive impact on society.

The goal is to broaden your knowledge about someone or something that challenges you to think and grow in some area of your life.

Step 2: Turn in the summer reading assignment on Thursday the second week of school.

Assignment:

- 1. List the title and author.
- 2. Explain in 5 or more sentences why you selected the book that you chose.
- 3. Keep a chapter journal for each chapter of the book of 4-5 sentences.
- 4. Answer this question for each chapter in 2-3 sentences: "What did I learn from this chapter that I do not want to forget and that I can share with someone else?
- 5. In 5-6 sentences, explain what you learned from reading this book and how you plan to apply this in your life.

This assignment should be typed with a title page containing your name, the book you chose, the assignment name, and Mr. Connatser.
